Bridge making

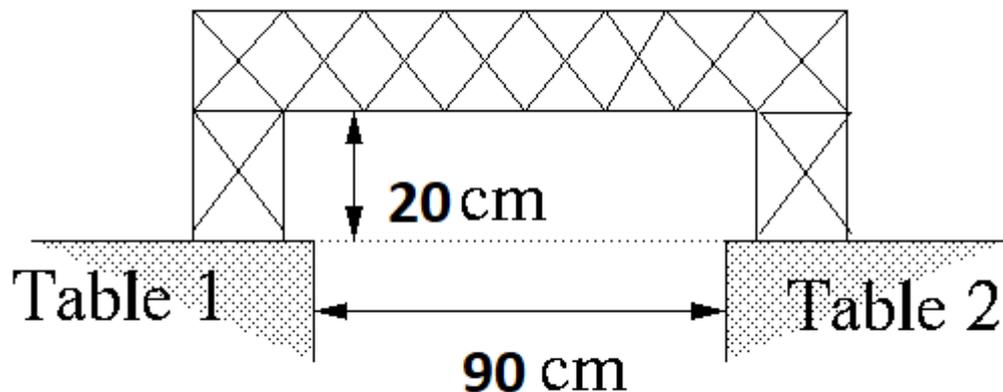
Topic: Popsicle sticks bridge

A. Objective

To build the bridge within our specifications that has the highest payload to weight ratio. The bridge must be constructed of approved materials.

B. Apparatus

- Building Materials:
 1. Popsicle sticks.
 2. Fevicol.
- Dimensions:
 1. Min Span Length - 90 cm - min. There will be a 90 centimeter "gap" which must be spanned by the bridge.
 2. Max Span Width - 15 cm - min.
 3. Min Span Height – 20 cm - min. There must be 20 centimeters between the table surface and the lowest point on the bridge span.
 4. **Rule update #2** Diagram presented for clarification:



5. The bridge must be able to stand on its own.
6. The bridge must be able to support the load at the loading points. There will be two loading points, each one will be at the "deck" level, 20 centimeters from the center of the span.

C. The Competition

1. Teams must submit their bridge 1/2 hour before the competition for inspection.
2. Inspection will test that the construction rules were followed and will record the mass of the bridge.
3. Certified bridges will be placed over "Crusher Canyon" by the team members, who may make final adjustments in its position. The canyon will consist of a 60 cm space between two flat desktops. Nothing will be provided to keep the base of the bridge in place during loading.
4. Once the bridge is in position, the loading tray will be attached in the position indicated above. The load will hang below the bridge, supported by two bars which rest on the deck of the bridge, 20 centimetres from each end.
5. Bridges will then be subjected to loading. Bridge failure will be considered the point at which the bridge breaks or the point at which the loading tray drops more than 5 centimetres from the unloaded position.

D. Judging and Scoring

1. The greatest load prior to failure will be a bridge's capacity.
2. The capacity divided by the bridge mass will be the bridge's score.
3. The bridge with the highest score wins the event.

15. After you have submitted the soft copy, a panel of judges will go through your material and if you are shortlisted to give the presentation, you will notify.
16. The abstract mail should contain abstract, references, your email id and mobile number.
17. The decision of judges will be final and no arguments or appeal will be entertained.

Topic: Basic Questions of All Field

Rules:

GENERAL RULES

1. A team shall consist of max two persons.
2. The decision of the quiz-master will be final and will not be subjected to any change.
3. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments.
4. The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, True / False statement, Specific-answer question etc.
5. Audience shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors.
6. Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after registration
7. Teams selected for the final rounds will be allowed to give themselves an appropriate name related to the competition by which they may want to be known

ELIMINATION ROUND –

- Each student would be given a set of question paper containing 30 multiple choice objective type questions
- Time limit - 30 minutes
- Only 5 Teams would be selected for STAGE ROUNDS
- In case of tie between 2 or more teams, further 5 questions would be asked for final selection
- The selected teams shall have to appear for the final round

FINAL QUIZ STAGE ROUNDS

Round 1: A question will be asked to a team and if they are unable to answer it will be passed to the next team - Rounds 4- **20 questions**

- Each team would be asked 4 questions each.
- 10 marks for correct answer and 5 negative marks for wrong answer.

- If a team cannot answer the question, they can pass the question & then the question would be forwarded to the next team.
- Answering time is only 30 seconds.
- Team discussion is allowed.

Round 2: Rapid Fire Round: -Each team will be asked 10 questions one after another in one minutes time- : **50 questions**

- 10 marks for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong answer
- Answering time is only 5 seconds
- Team discussion is allowed
- If a team cannot answer the question, they can say pass for the next question. The question will **not** be forwarded to the next team.

Round 3 – Buzzer Round- A question will be fired & the team who presses the buzzer first get to answer first – **6 Questions**

- 10 marks for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong or if team doesn't after they press Buzzers. – No forwarding
- Answering time is only 30 seconds

Round 4- Audio-visual round

Teams will be shown clips and will have to answer. Rounds 2 : **12 questions**

- 10 marks for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong answer
- Each Team would be asked 2 audio-visual questions. (1 slide in each round)
- Answering time is only 30 seconds.
- No passing to the next team. Audience can answer.
